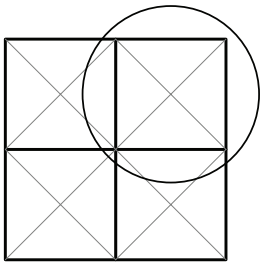
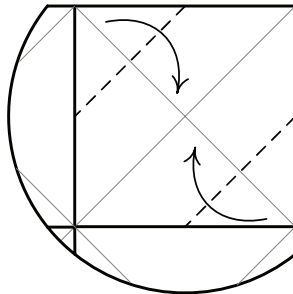


Butterfly Cube

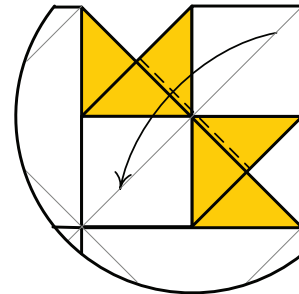
Make a Four-Sink Base as explained in the previous section. To avoid creases at the center from showing, do not crease the center of the paper when doing Step 1 of the base.



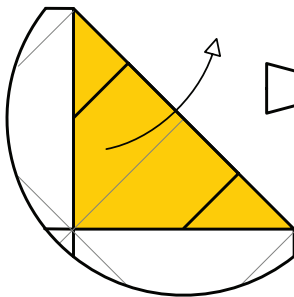
1. Start with the back side of the Four-Sink Base facing you.



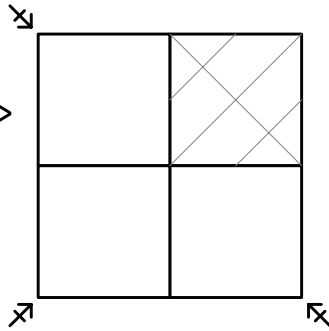
2. Fold the two corners shown.



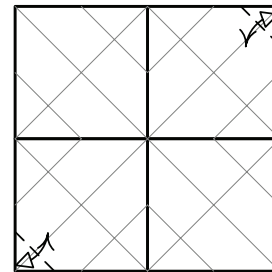
3. Fold the corner in.



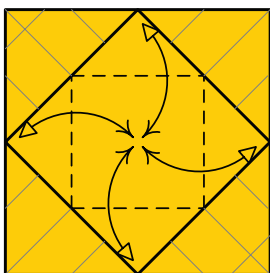
4. Unfold to Step 1.



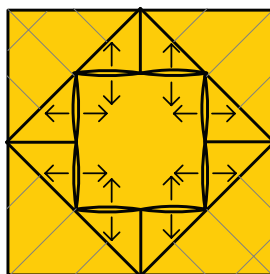
5. Repeat Steps 2–4 at other corners.



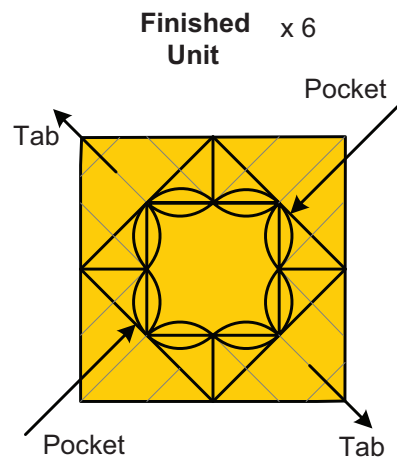
6. Fold and unfold tips slightly to mark tabs (optional). Turn over.

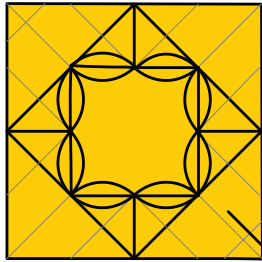


7. Fold and unfold the four corners shown, then orient them to point towards you.



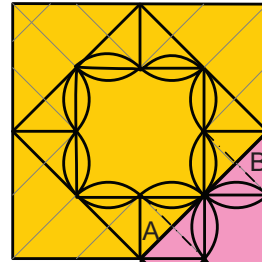
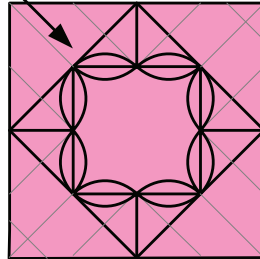
8. For each corner now pointing towards you, spread open the slits and curve outwards.



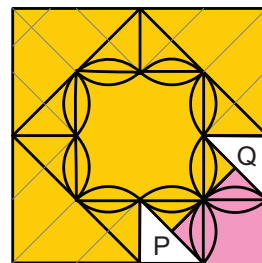
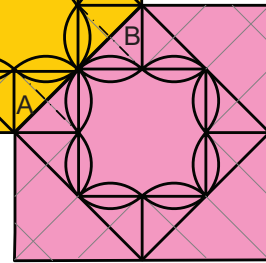


Assembly

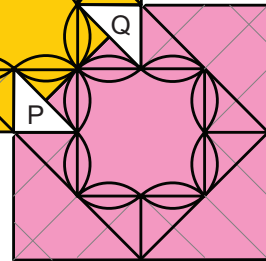
Insert tab into pocket.



Mountain fold tips A and B, both units together.



Two units locked.



Mountain fold line PQ, both units together. PQ will lie along one edge of the finished cube. Continue assembling all six units similarly such that each unit lies on a face of the finished cube and each locked joint lies on an edge of the cube.
